THE SHARE CHALLENGE

Anti-Christian forces are advancing from the north in large numbers toward the south, into the sub-Saharan Africa, a region that for over a century has witnessed and spread the only true freedom found only in Christ Jesus. Kenya borders a few of the predominantly anti-Christian countries just north of the Equator. With at least 20 million of her 38 million people confessing to be active Evangelical Christians, Kenya has the potential to withstand the advance of anti-Christian forces by building a strong "Buffer Zone of Truth" along the Equator. Turkana land is strategically and geographically located as a perfect center for such a zone!

Share International, Inc. (SI) has been building such a zone since 1997 by training, sending, and supporting indigenous pastors and missionaries through donations of people like you. A Buffer Zone of Truth is emerging! By 2010, 98 churches had been planted by 10 pastors (@ \$150/mo/pastor) and 23 missionaries (@ \$180/mo/missionary)! We are thankful to the Lord; it's His doing. We still have 49 of the 72 missionaries that we have trained still waiting to be sent to the hundreds unreached villages.

Even though the task remains daunting, it's absolutely doable with God's help through His people! We must train, send, and support many more indigenous missionaries NOW! The

time is NOW for SI to move to the next "combative" phase by constructing a facility in Lodwar from where we can Share Eternity through Nationals Daily ("SEND") with those that have fallen victims of the enemy of Truth across and north of the African Equator. If the Church fails to SEND more trained nationals to this region at this very critical hour, Kenya, and other nations in the sub-Saharan Africa, will be forced to adopt and be subjected to the anti-Christian laws in the near future. That would be a most devastating retreat and withdrawal by the Church.

The SEND Conference Center will also serve as a crossroads outreach and guest stop center for the many national and international visitors in transit between Kenya, Uganda, Ethiopia, Sudan, and Somalia along The Great North Road and the expanding Lodwar Airstrip. The Center will generate sustainable income to provide employment to many of the SI Children of the Kingdom (COK) sponsored students who have graduated from high school and college the past several years. SITE LOCATION

Lodwar is the largest town in North Western Kenya located 50 km west of Lake Turkana.

Located 515m above seal level, the area is generally hot and dry. Temperature range from lows of 32 C° (90 F°) to highs of 46 C° (115 F°). Average rainfall is about 40mm.

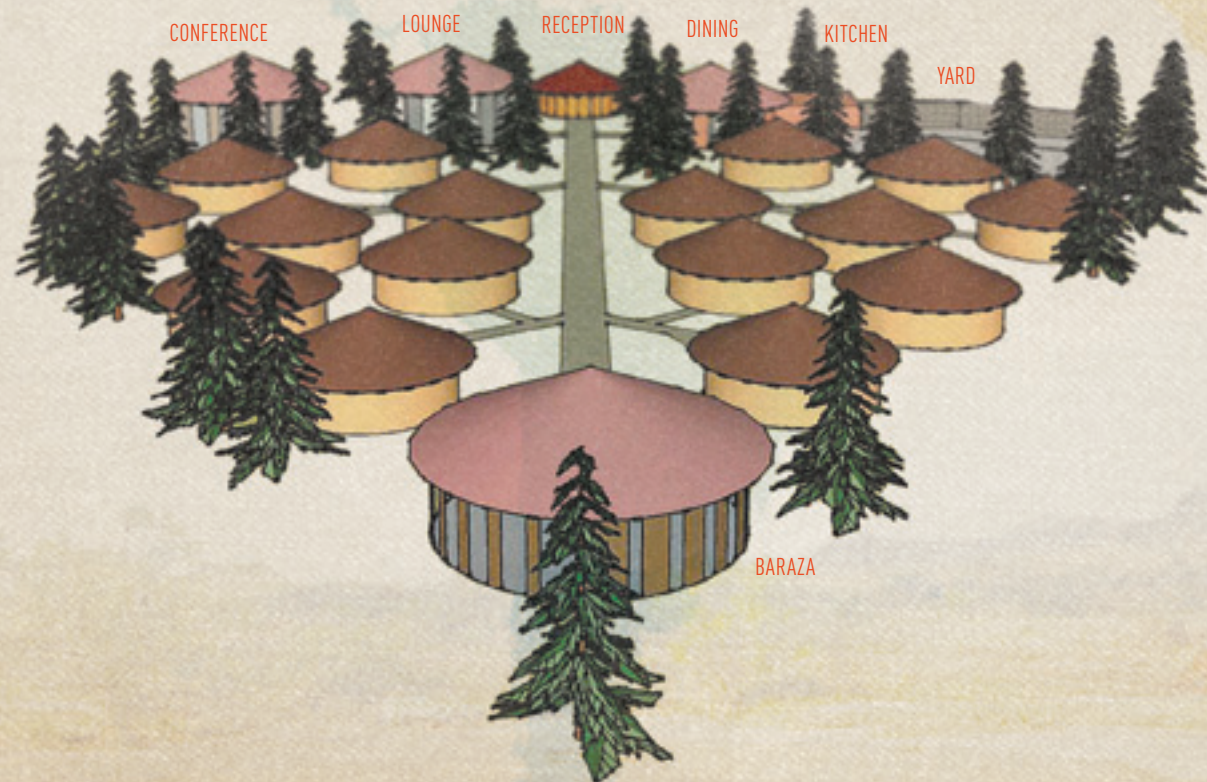
The site is a five acre piece of land located in the outskirts of Lodwar. Currently the site has three structures scattered across its edges.

It is on this land that Share International proposes a conference centre that will have the following facilities:

- An administrative area
- Conference halls with support facilities
- Accommodation



CONCEPTUAL MODEL



DESIGN CONCEPT

The concept borrows its architectural formation technology from the local environment.

Making use of local building materials and borrowing from the Turkana traditional architectural styles, our concept makes use of the local solutions to curb building costs and mitigate against harsh climatic conditions. In addition, its planning allows cross ventilation across the site and within the individual units.



Pictured left is traditional Turkana houses and a detailed shot of the intricate reed work that is used to construct the houses.

1 BUMA

This is a circular unit that has two rooms on ground level which are accessed from a terrace. The unit has an area of 76 sq meters.

COST/UNIT: \$687.50



2 BUME

This unit has four rooms on the same level, all of which are accessed from a common terrace. The unit has an area of 116 sq meters.

COST/UNIT: \$687.50



3 TURKWANA

This is a duplex unit consisting of four rooms on two levels with a small lounge. It has a balcony on the upper level accessed from the gallery area. The unit has an area of 151 sq meters.
